Dr. N. K. Banthiya Memorial Scholarship

Preamble: Prof. (Dr.) N. K. Banthiya was the founder Head of the Department of Mechanical Engineering and later on Head, Programme Assessment and Quality Improvement Cell, SKIT, Jaipur. Prior to his joining SKIT he was Professor and Head, NITTTR, Bhopal. In his memory Mrs. Shakuntala Banthiya donated Rs. 10.00 lakhs for the award of scholarship, to students of Mechanical Engineering of SKIT on merit-cum-means basis.

Procedure: Applications for the award of scholarships will be invited from all the eligible students of B. Tech. II, III and Final year students of Mechanical Engineering branch at the beginning of each academic session and the selection will be done by a Committee consisting of the Principal, Head Mechanical Engineering Department and the nominee of the Management:

Eligibility

- 1. All bonafied and regular students of Mechanical Engineering Branch of B. Tech. II, III and Final year and whose parents' income (combined income of both parents) is less than Rs. 2.0 lakhs per annum and who have passed the previous University examination in single attempt without any backlog are eligible to apply for the scholarship. The students admitted under Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme, Management Quota or receiving financial support from any other source are not eligible to apply.
- 2. Students with any financial dues in the previous year/session will not be considered for the award of scholarship.

Procedure

1. Merit list of eligible students will be prepared on the basis of previous year/semester University examination by the award committee. The number and amount of scholarship may vary each year and will depend upon the availability of funds.

- 2. In general the scholarships will be awarded on merit-cum-means basis.

 However, the preference will be given to those applicants whose parents are not alive (supporting document will be required).
- 3. The applicant will have to produce documentary evidence of combined income of both parents from the appropriate authority.
- 4. The recipients of scholarship will be required to give an undertaking duly counter signed by their parents/guardians that they will remain regular and maintain attendance more than 75% in each theory/tutorial/laboratory separately and also strictly abide by the rules and regulations of the Institute, failing which the scholarship will be discontinued and the awardees may be asked to refund the previously awarded amount.
- 5. The merit list of applicants will be prepared on the basis of the result available at the time of submission of application. Change in result due to retotaling/revaluation will not be considered if declared after the last date of receiving applications.

Institutional Support

On the recommendations of the committee selected students may also be given books on loan from the Institute's book bank without any charge. This will be in additionto the number of books issued to the students from the library.
