## *About SKIT*

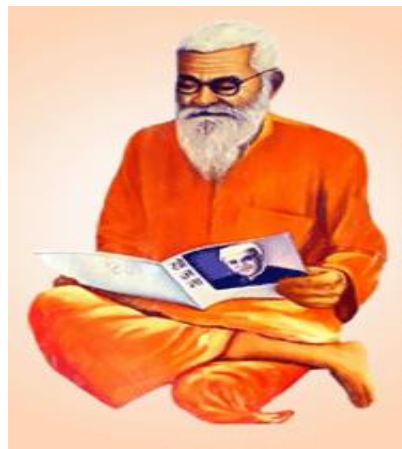

## 2. INTRODUCTION:

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME popularly known as NSS was launched in Gandhi's Birth Centenary Year 1969, under the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports Govt. of India. The scheme was launched simultaneously in 37 Universities involving 40,000 students with primary focus on the development of personality of students through community service and promotion of National solidarity. In India, the idea of involving students in the task of national service dates back to the times of Mahatma Gandhi, the father of the nation. The central theme which he tried to impress upon his student audience time and again was that they should always keep before them, their social responsibility. The first duty of the students should be, not to treat their period of study as one of the opportunities for indulgence in intellectual luxury, but for preparing themselves for final dedication in the service of those who provided the sinews of the nation with the national goods & services so essential to society. Advising them to form a living contact with the community in whose midst their institution is located, he suggested that instead of undertaking academic research about economic and social disability, the students should do "something positive so that the life of the villagers might be raised to a higher material and moral level". NSS works on the premise that it is possible to awaken the villagers and slum dwellers to their responsibilities and develop in them the confidence, to tackle their common problems with energy, enthusiasm and in a co-operative spirit, based on mutual aid and self-reliance. The role of students is limited as activists, enablers, catalytic agents with wider communities and as program aids.

### 2.1 The main objectives of National Service Scheme (NSS) are:

- Understand the community in which they work.
- Understand themselves in relation to their community.
- Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving.
- Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.



## INTRODUCTION OF SKIT SPECIAL CAMP

Volunteers Team of SKIT organized a 7 day special camp at a village named Dantli Tehsil at Saganer, Jaipur from 25<sup>th</sup> February to 2<sup>th</sup> March-2020. Students noted down each and every minor detail which they came across in the introduction session.

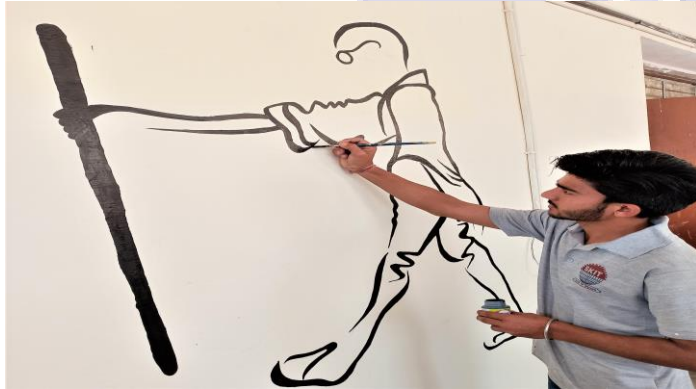
## 6.6 DAY SIXTH OF CAMP (01<sup>st</sup> MARCH, 2020)

Girl volunteers created awareness for Health and Hygiene of women and educated them about the proper usage of and disposal of sanitary pads.

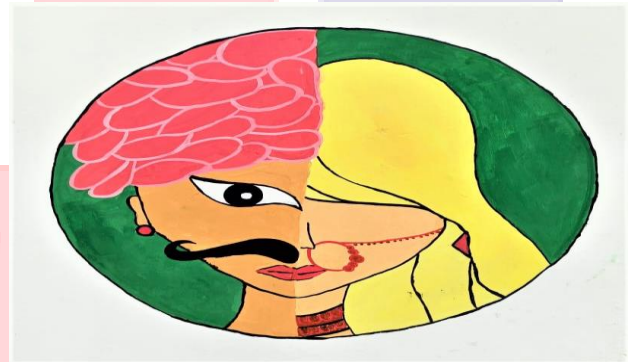
