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1. About Intellectual Property Rights Cell (IPR Cell)

The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Cell is a strategic initiative established by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the Institute, aimed at fostering a robust framework for the protection and management of intellectual property. Officially inaugurated on August 19, 2021, the IPR Cell was launched by two distinguished individuals: Dr. Manu Sikarwar, the IPR Project Director at the Department of Science and Technology (DST) Rajasthan, and Dr. D. K. Palwalia, the Dean of the IPR Cell at Rajasthan Technical University (RTU), Kota.

The IPR Cell operates in close collaboration with the Institute's Innovation Cell and Incubation Cell, creating a synergistic environment for innovation and intellectual property management. This partnership enhances the IPR Cell's capacity to serve as a vital entity within the Institute, fulfilling several key functions.

2. Aims and Objectives of IPR Cell

The following are aims and objectives of Institute's IPR Cell:

1. Education and Awareness:

- 1.1 Workshops and Seminars: Organize regular workshops and seminars on intellectual property for students, faculty, and staff.
- 1.2 Educational Materials: Develop and distribute educational materials, including brochures, pamphlets, and online resources, to enhance understanding.

2. IP Policy Development:

- 2.1 Policy Framework: Formulate a comprehensive IP policy that clearly defines ownership, rights, and the procedures for disclosure and protection.
- 2.2 Stakeholder Input: Involve stakeholders, including faculty, researchers, and legal experts, in the development and refinement of the policy.

3. Invention Disclosure Process:

- 3.1 Guidance and Support: Provide guidance and support to inventors during the disclosure process, including workshops and one-on-one consultations.
- 3.2 Confidentiality Assurance: Ensure confidentiality and establish trust to encourage inventors to disclose their inventions without fear of unauthorized disclosure.

4. Patent Filing and Protection:

- 4.1 Expert Consultation: Collaborate with patent attorneys and experts to assess the patentability of inventions.

4.2 Timely Filing: Implement a streamlined process to ensure timely filing of patent applications to protect inventions.

5. Licensing and Commercialization:

5.1 Market Analysis: Conduct market analysis to identify potential licensing opportunities for patented technologies.

5.2 Negotiation Support: Assist in negotiations between inventors and potential licensees to ensure fair and mutually beneficial agreements.

6. Research Collaboration Agreements:

6.1 Clear Agreements: Develop clear and comprehensive research collaboration agreements outlining IP rights, responsibilities, and revenue-sharing mechanisms.

6.2 Dispute Resolution: Include provisions for dispute resolution in case of disagreements among collaborators.

7. Monitoring and Enforcement:

7.1 Regular Audits: Conduct regular audits to monitor the use of intellectual property and identify potential infringements.

7.2 Legal Actions: Work closely with legal experts to initiate legal actions when necessary to enforce IP rights.

8. Technology Transfer Office:

8.1 Dedicated Staff: Assign dedicated staff to manage the Technology Transfer Office and facilitate seamless technology transfer processes.

8.2 Networking: Build a strong network with industry partners to explore potential collaborations and technology transfer opportunities.

9. Documentation and Record Keeping:

9.1 Centralized Database: Establish a centralized and secure database to document and store all information related to IP, including disclosures, patents, agreements, and licensing details.

9.2 Access Controls: Implement access controls to ensure that only authorized personnel have access to sensitive information.

10. Collaboration with Legal Experts:

10.1 Legal Workshops: Arrange workshops and sessions with legal experts to keep stakeholders informed about evolving IP laws and regulations.

10.2 Legal Advisory Services: Provide ongoing legal advisory services to address specific queries and concerns related to intellectual property.

11. Promotion of Innovation and Creativity:

11.1 Incentive Programs: Introduce incentive programs such as awards, recognition, and grants to encourage innovation and creativity.

11.2 Incubation Support: Collaborate with incubation centers to support the development and commercialization of innovative ideas.

12. Ethical Considerations:

12.1 Code of Ethics: Establish a code of ethics related to intellectual property to guide the behavior of all stakeholders.

12.2 Ethics Training: Conduct training sessions on ethical considerations in intellectual property management.

Event Report on Counselling Session on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Awareness for Startups

Date: 12 March, 2025

Venue: Startup Expo, Girl Hostel Ground, SKITM&G Jaipur

Type of Activity: Counselling / Awareness Session

A dedicated counselling session on "Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Awareness for Startups" was successfully conducted on 12th March, 2025 at the Startup Expo hosted on the grounds of SKITM&G, Jaipur. The session was strategically organized to integrate with the expo, ensuring direct access to a vibrant community of budding entrepreneurs and student innovators. The primary focus was to demystify the complexities of IPR and provide actionable guidance to protect intellectual capital from its inception.

The session was designed with the following key objectives:

- To create foundational and practical awareness of Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) among early-stage startups.
- To provide clear guidance on the nuances and filing processes for patents, copyrights, and trademarks.
- To motivate student innovators to protect their ideas and understand the path to commercialization through incubation.

The session began by explaining the critical importance of IPR as a business asset and a tool for competitive advantage, rather than just a legal formality. The discussion was highly interactive, covering the distinct differences between patents, trademarks, copyrights, and trade secrets. The expert used relatable examples from the tech and creative industries to illustrate concepts. A significant portion was dedicated to the patent filing process in India, including prior art search, documentation, and timelines. The participants posed specific queries regarding their unique startup ideas, ranging from software applications and design innovations to brand names. The expert provided preliminary, on-the-spot counselling, advising on the appropriate type of IP protection and the first steps involved.

Outcomes:

- Startups gained practical exposure to IP filing processes.
- Increased awareness of safeguarding innovation at the ideation stage.
- Encouraged participation of students in entrepreneurship and incubation programs.

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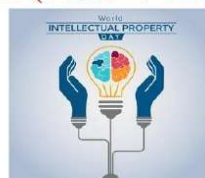

The keynote addresses formed the cornerstone of the inaugural session. The first keynote was delivered by Dr. Ramesh Mittal, Founder Director of the Innovation & Entrepreneurship Federation at CCS NIAM. Dr. Mittal, with his vast experience, provided an invigorating perspective on the ecosystem required to nurture innovation. He eloquently connected the dots between ideation, prototyping, and the crucial step of securing intellectual property to build sustainable entrepreneurial ventures. His talk was a compelling call to action for young innovators to think boldly and protect diligently.

The second keynote speaker, Dr. Ashwin M. Dalvi, Former Chairman of the Rajasthan Lalit Kala Academy, offered a unique and invaluable viewpoint by focusing on the protection of creative and artistic works. He delved into the nuances of copyrights, moral rights, and the challenges faced by artists in the digital age. Dr. Dalvi's address beautifully complemented Dr. Mittal's, creating a holistic understanding of the "IP Nexus" by covering both technological innovation and artistic creativity.



The inaugural ceremony concluded with a formal Vote of Thanks delivered by Ms. Smirli Jain from the Department of Electrical Engineering. She expressed gratitude to the management, organizers, speakers, and participants for their unwavering support. Session II: Online Session – Global Insights on Innovation (10:30 AM – 12:00 PM)

Post the high tea, the conference seamlessly transitioned into its first technical session, an online segment designed to incorporate global expertise. The session commenced at 10:30 AM with an invited talk by Dr. T. Pawan Kumar, Principal Scientist & Manager at InTEC. The session was adeptly chaired by Mr. Harshal Nigam (Assistant Professor, ECE) and coordinated by Mr. Praveen Saraswat (Associate Professor, ME).

Dr. Kumar's talk, delivered virtually, provided a deep dive into the practical aspects of managing innovation within research and development environments. He shared cutting-edge insights on technology transfer, the process of patenting scientific discoveries, and the strategic management of intellectual capital in corporate labs. His presentation was rich with real-world case studies, illustrating the journey of an idea from the lab bench to the marketplace, protected by a robust IP framework. The interactive Q&A session that followed saw active participation from the audience, who queried Dr. Kumar on topics ranging from patent filing strategies to the future of AI-generated inventions.



This was followed by a paper presentation session from 11:30 AM onwards. Researchers and academicians presented their original work on various facets of intellectual property. The presentations covered a diverse range of topics, including analyses of patent landscapes in emerging technologies, the economic impact of trademark regimes, and case studies on copyright issues in the software industry. This session provided a platform for scholarly exchange and showcased the high-quality research being conducted in the field.

After a networking lunch at the Guest House, the conference reconvened for the afternoon offline session in the J C Bose Auditorium. This segment focused on the legal intricacies of Intellectual Property Rights.

The session began at 1:00 PM with a powerful and insightful invited talk by Adv.(Dr.) Rohit Jain, an esteemed IPR expert. The session was chaired by Dr. Rishi Vyas (Professor, Physics) and coordinated by Ms. Smirli Jain (Associate Professor, EE). Adv. Jain's talk was a masterclass in the practical application of IP law. He demystified complex legal doctrines, explained the procedural nuances of patent litigation in India, and highlighted recent landmark judgments that are shaping the IP landscape. His emphasis on the importance of due diligence and freedom-to-operate analyses was particularly enlightening for aspiring entrepreneurs and researchers. The engaging presentation was punctuated with anecdotes from his legal practice, making the content both accessible and highly relevant.



The event drew to a formal close with a Vote of Thanks and the official closing of the conference.
