The Department of Management Studies organized a vibrant MBA Fresher's event titled "FreshHitz 2K25" on 4th October 2025 at the Gyan Mandir Auditorium. The program was designed to warmly welcome newly admitted MBA first-semester students and help them integrate into the departmental culture. The event began with a traditional lamp-lighting ceremony in reverence to Goddess Saraswati, followed by a devotional bhajan that set a serene tone. Dr. Savita Choudhary, Head of the Department, addressed the gathering and extended her best wishes to the freshers, encouraging them to embrace academic excellence and holistic development. The celebration featured a range of cultural performances, competitions, and interactive games such as Puzzle Run, creating an atmosphere of enthusiasm and camaraderie between juniors and seniors. In-house Training Program on Technical & Managerial Skills

The Department of Management Studies conducted focused technical training sessions designed to strengthen students' professional competency in management. The first session, AI & Tools, delivered by Mr. Mukesh Vyas (Senior Consultant, Infosys), introduced students to practical applications of emerging AI platforms such as ChatGPT, Canva AI, Notion AI, and Google Gemini. The session emphasized responsible AI use, automation, data-driven decision-making, and the growing relevance of digital tools in modern business environments. Alongside demonstrations, students explored how AI enhances productivity, creativity, and analytical thinking. The second technical session, HRM Basic Terminologies, was conducted by Dr. Ona Ladiwal, focusing on foundational concepts like recruitment, selection, performance appraisal, compensation, and employee relations. These essential HR terms were explained through corporate examples, helping students connect theory with organisational practice. A quiz activity added an interactive element, allowing students to reinforce HR concepts in a practical, engaging manner. Together, both sessions strengthened students' technical understanding essential for managerial roles.



In-house Training Program on Communication & Personal Development

The Third training session was on Your Degree and Your Day-to-Day Life, delivered by Mr. Subroject Gupta. This session helped students understand how classroom learning extends beyond academics into daily professional behaviour. Time management, communication, decision-making, and problem- solving were highlighted as essential life skills. Through relatable examples and discussions, students were encouraged to view their degree as a tool for personal growth and confident workplace readiness. The forth session, Communication & CriticalThinking – Art of Cracking Interviews, was conducted by Ms. Anushree Dixit. This workshop covered grooming, body language, clarity in speech, and interview etiquette. Students learned to express ideas confidently, structure responses effectively, and develop a strong personal presence during interviews. The session helped build confidence, critical thinking, and self- presentation skills, completing the soft- skill development needed for industry preparedness. Industrial Visits

The Department of Management Studies organized three industrial visits to provide MBA students with practical industry exposure. The first visit was to Dev Milk Foods Pvt. Ltd. (FRUBON), where students observed modern dairy and ice-cream manufacturing, quality control processes, and large-scale supply chain operations, gaining insights into production, branding, and FMCG management. The second visit was to Design2Occupancy Services LLP (D2O/D2C), a leading sustainability consulting firm. Students learned about energy auditing, green building practices, digital simulation tools, and the growing importance of ESG and environmental compliance in modern businesses. The Third visit was to Saras Sankul, Jaipur Dairy, where students explored cooperative dairy operations, including milk procurement, processing, packaging, and distribution. The visit highlighted quality assurance, farmer– centric systems, and efficient supply-chain management.



Alumni Interaction

The Department of Management Studies organized two Alumni Interaction sessions under the Synergy initiative to connect students with real corporate experiences. In the first session, alumna Ms. Ekta Modi (MBA 2021–2023), currently an Operations Associate in R2R, shared her professional journey and highlighted the importance of perseverance, adaptability, and continuous learning. She emphasized soft skills, teamwork, internships, and networking as essential tools for career growth while explaining the R2R process in finance operations. The second session featured Mr. Rohan Kotia and Ms. Payal Gupta (MBA 2023–2025), who discussed transitioning into the corporate world. Rohan focused on analytical thinking, upskilling, and balancing technical and interpersonal abilities, while Payal stressed discipline, time management, and overcoming initial career challenges with resilience. Their guidance offered students clarity on placement readiness, communication, leadership, and professional ethics.



International Faculty Development Program

The Department of Management Studies, in collaboration with Eudoxia Research University, USA, conducted a ten-day virtual International Faculty Development Program on “Ethical Application of AI in Higher Education” from 8–17 September 2025. The programme engaged 120 faculty members, focusing on AI-driven teaching, research, and administration while emphasizing ethics, academic integrity, and NEP 2020 guidelines.

Sessions covered ethical foundations of AI, use of advanced AI tools, administrative automation, and responsible application of Generative AI, along with hands-on training. The FDP highlighted that AI should augment educators rather than replace them. Key takeaways stressed transparency, ethical usage, institutional readiness, and the importance of AI literacy for future-ready education.



ICMBE-2025

The Department of Management Studies, SKIT M&G, Jaipur, successfully organized the International Conference on Management, Business, and Economy (ICMBE–2025) on December 2– 3, 2025. The conference brought together academicians, industry leaders, researchers, and policymakers to discuss emerging trends in management, business, economics, and technology, with a focus on digital transformation, sustainability, ESG practices, and entrepreneurship. The event began with Saraswati Vandana and the ceremonial lamp lighting, followed by the Welcome Address of Prof. S. L. Surana and the conference theme presented by Dr. Ajay Verma. 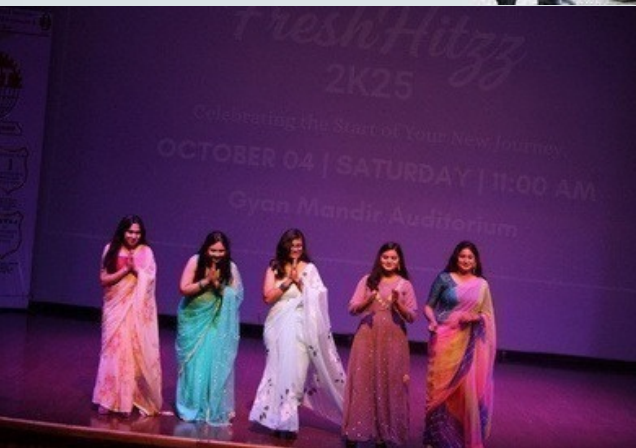
*Expert Lecture on
