Students shall choose a right option from following options are given below:

Mode	Option
Regular	Students may register for regular industrial training/internship from recognized Industry/Institution, if his/her circumstances allows as per the prevailing lockdown conditions.
Online	<p>In case of any difficulty to undergo with regular training/Internship, such students may choose anyone option from following options to undergo for industrial training/internship:</p> <p>Option-1: Students can register for training/internship leading to a valid and verifiable certificate from standard agencies like Internshala, LetsINTERN, LinkedIN, Hello Intern, Twenty19, Angellist, OysterConnect, Indian internship, Interlelo etc.</p> <p>Option-2: Students from II semester and students from IV & VI semester may register to themselves for at least one course and two such courses from standard websites like- Lynda, Udemy, Khan Academy, Coursera, Alison, edX, Futurelearn, Udacity, Bloc, Code Academy, Skillshare, Open Culture, Tuts+, Openlearn, Academic Earth, Stanford Online, Harvard Extension, Open Yale Courses, UC Berkeley Class Central, MIT Open Courseware, Carnegie Mellon Open Learning Initiative, Code, University of London, University of Oxford, SAP, Saylor, HubSpot, The Gymnasium, Channel9 MSDN, Google Digital Garage etc. The duration of each course should be atleast 4 weeks.</p> <p>Option-3: A team of four students can register for build a Startup. A certificate will be issued by the Incubation Cell /Startup cell of the institute.</p> <p>Option-4: In case of any student fails to find a workable above options; the respective department may assign some workable project assignment to such student under faculty member. This assignment may be substantive that equals to duration and credit assigned. Final completion certificate may be issued by HOD of the respective department and endorsed by the TPO of the Institute.</p>

After successful completion of internship/training/course etc., student will prepare a report as per the prescribed norms and submit it along with completion certificates to the concerned department of the institute.
