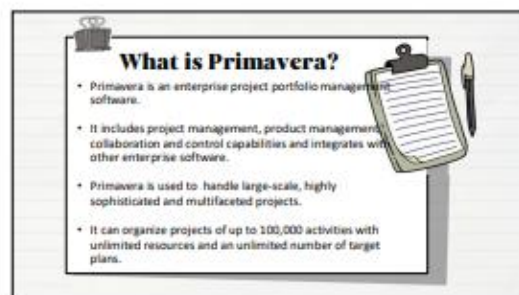
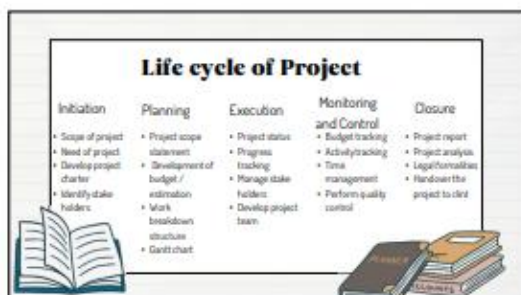
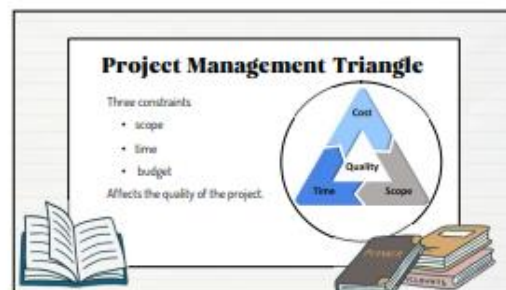
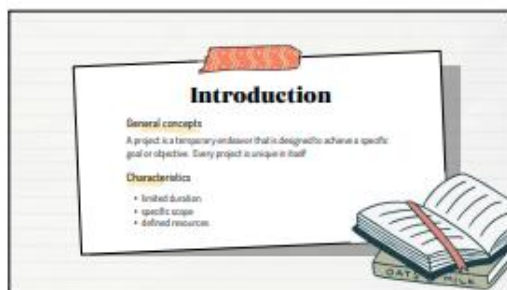
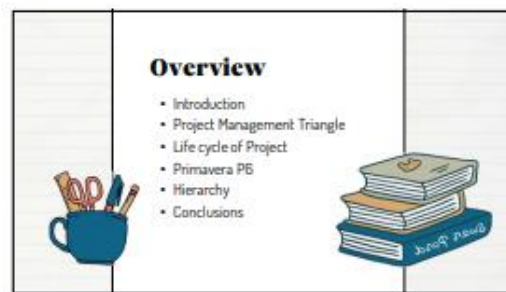


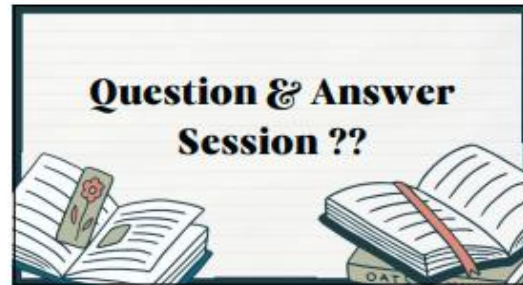
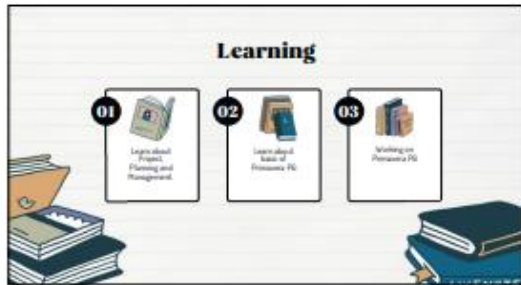
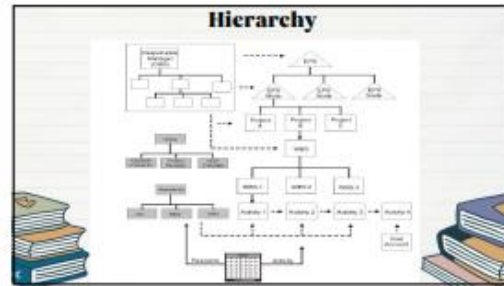
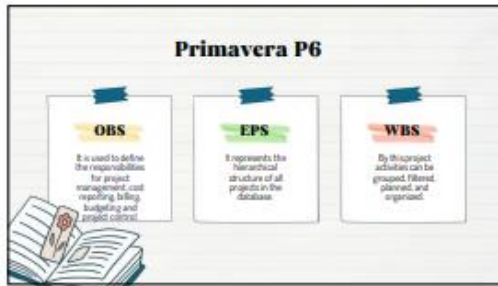
## Conclusion and Outcome of the workshop
