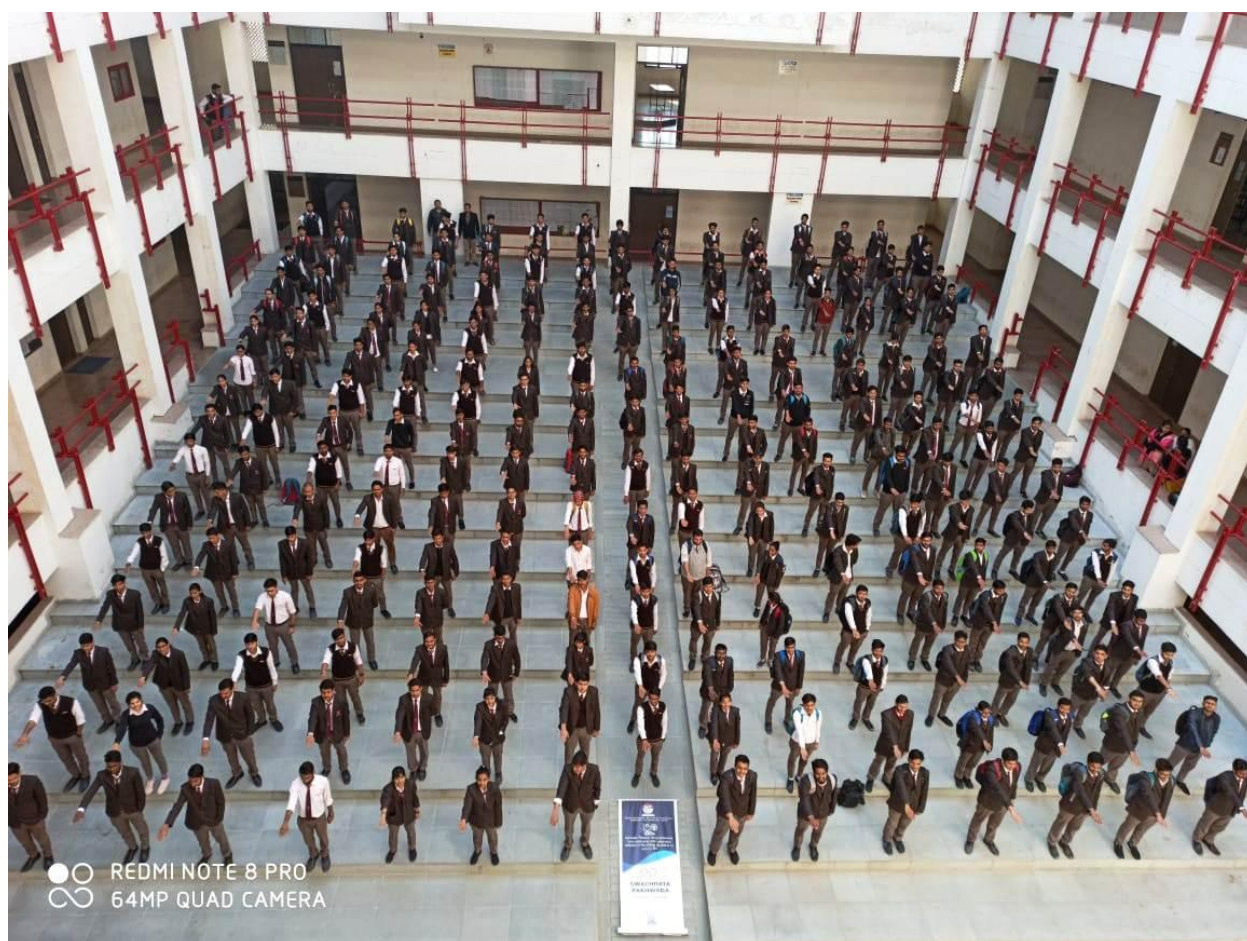


Fig: - Swachhata Pledge by Employees and Students of the Institute

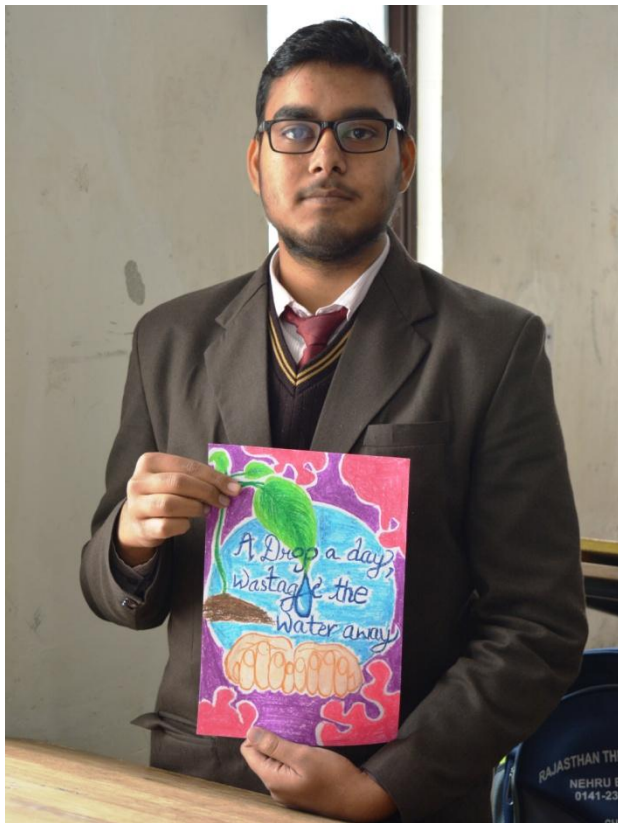

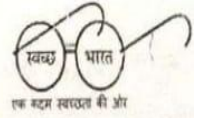

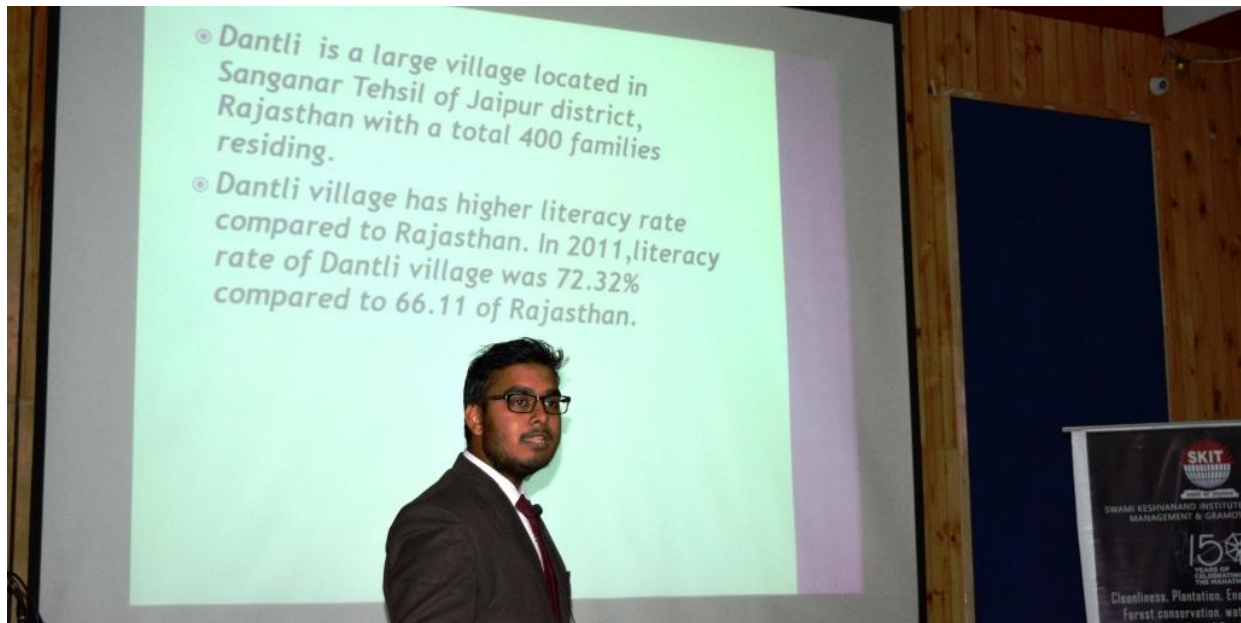


Fig: - Presentation of Reports on Activities at Dantli Village

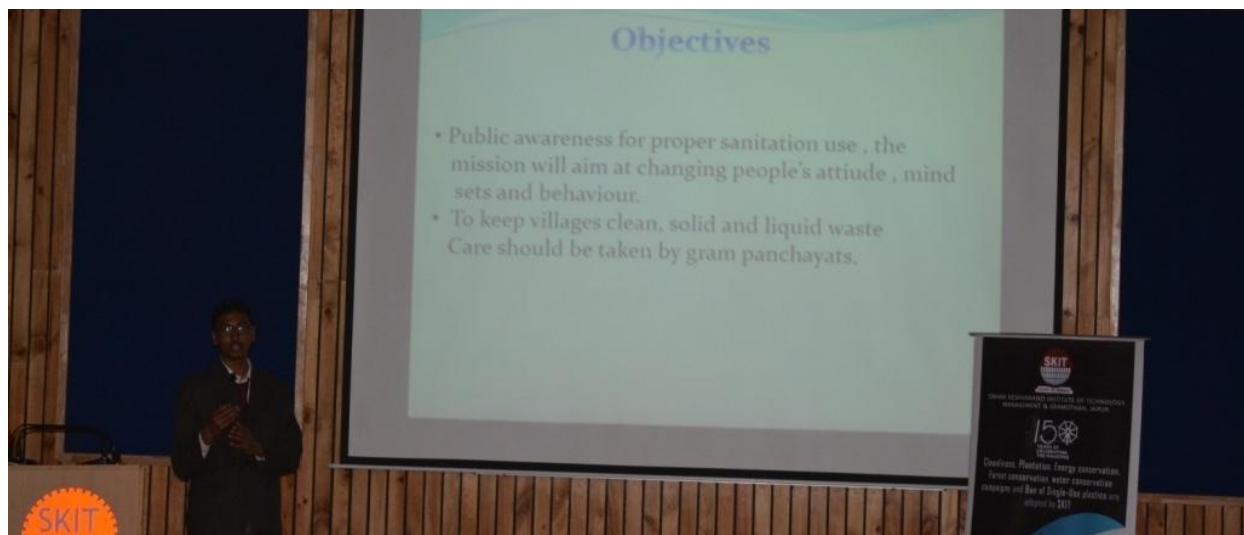


Fig: - Presentation of Reports on Activities at Dantli Village

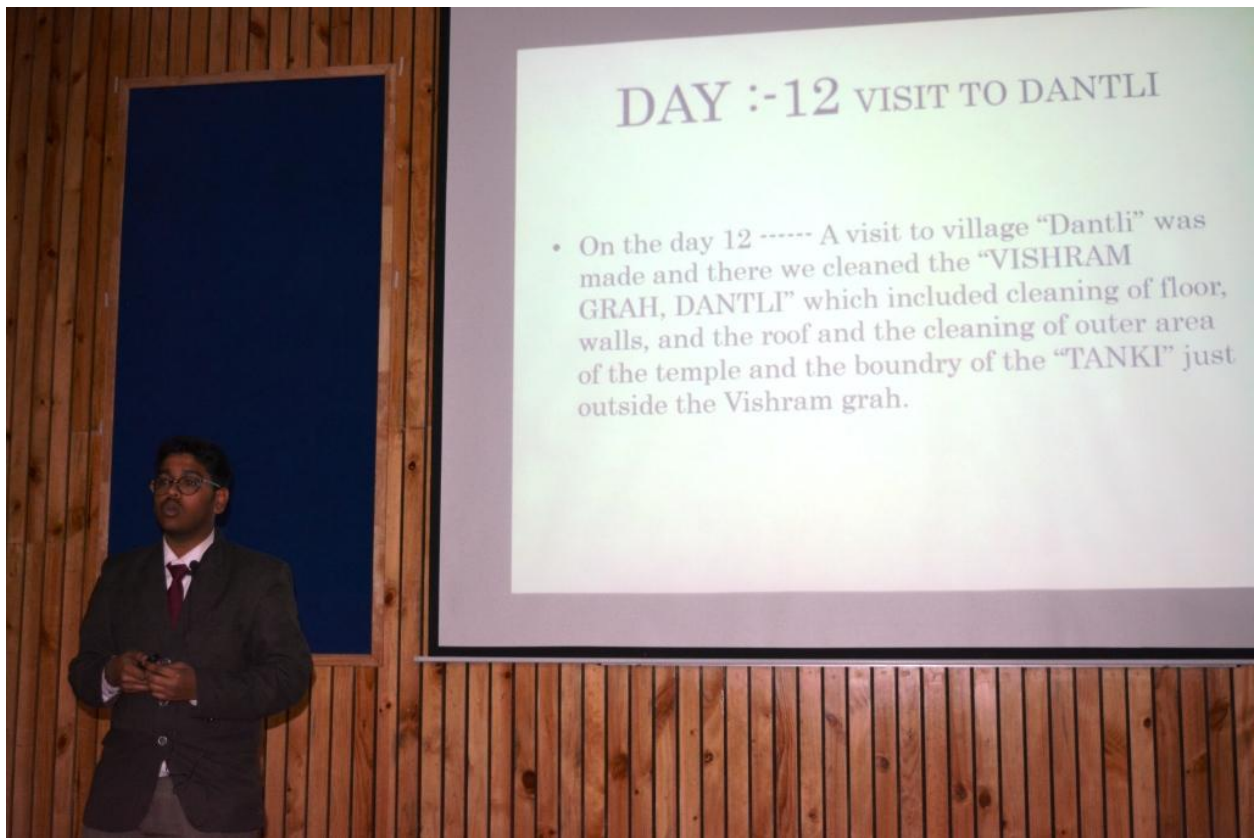


Fig: - Presentation of Reports on Activities at Dantli Village

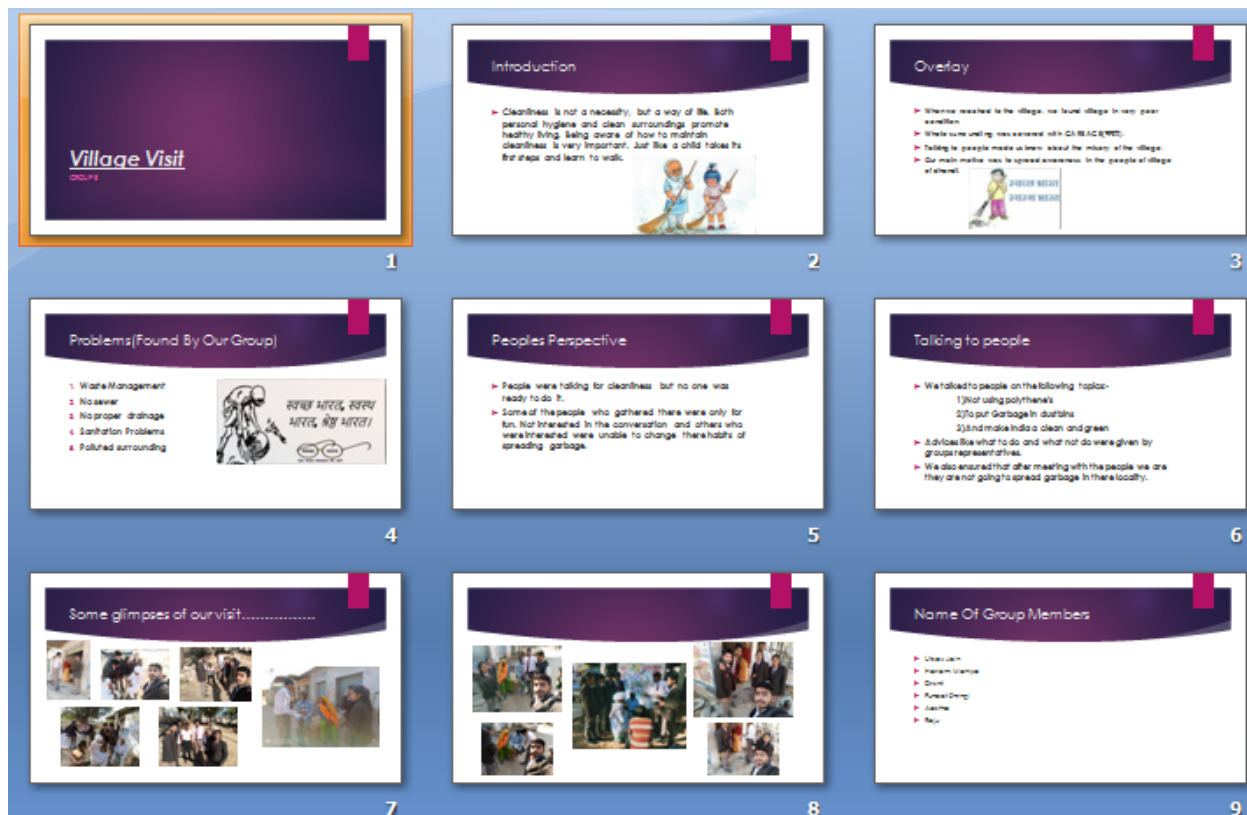


Fig - Presentation of Reports on Village Activities by Team B

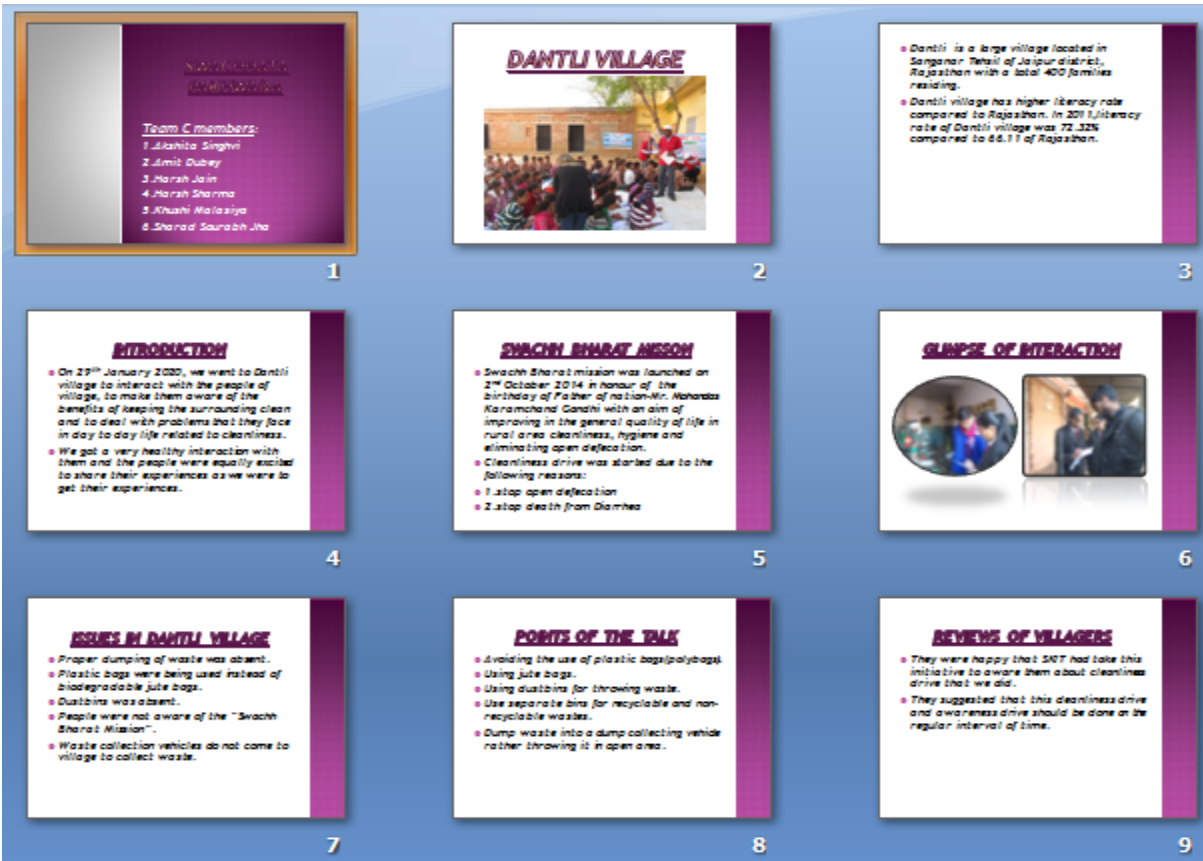


Fig: - Presentation of Reports on Village Activities by Team C

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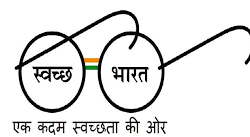
