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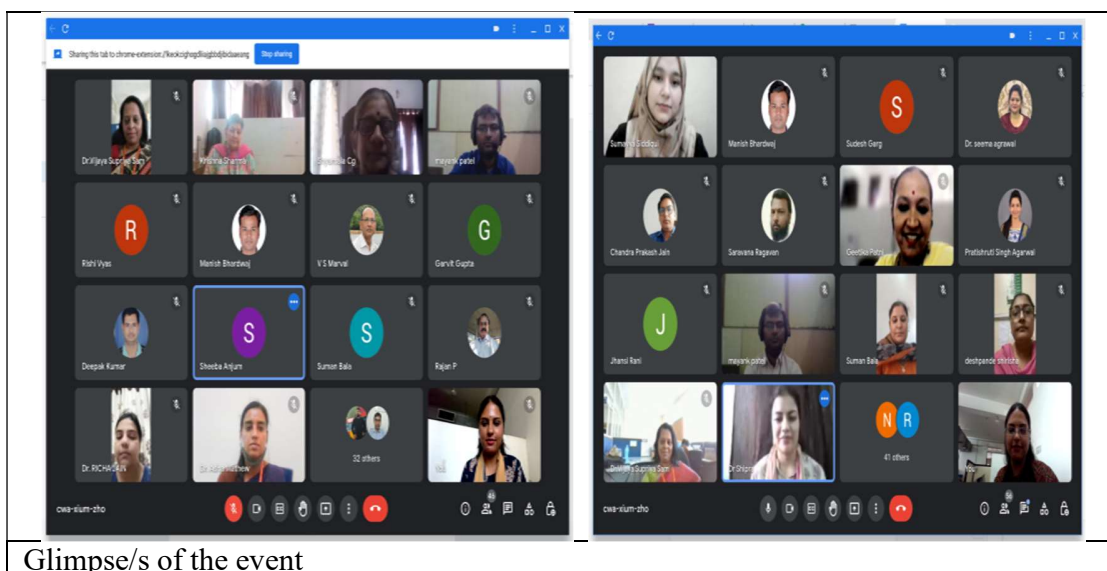
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**Name of the event:** FDP On “The Art of Effective Teaching in the light of NEP”

**About the event:** A One Week Faculty Development Program on “The Art of Effective Teaching in the light of NEP”

was organized by the Dept. of English from 12 Sept to 17 Sept 2022. This FDP focused on equipping the teaching fraternity with strategies and tools to bridge the gap between quality research and teaching with techniques that can disseminate knowledge to young learners effectively.. The goal of the FDP was to familiarize participants with challenges and changes in higher education in India as brought out in NEP 2020, with particular reference to the teaching and learning methodology, institutional governance research issues promotion, and, most importantly, the manner in which these impact the development of faculty members. The aim is to teach how to create a learning environment that supports the students to be academically successful. **Dr. Sunita Mishra** (Professor, Dept of English, University of Hyderabad) took a keynote session on “**Multilingual Education in India and NEP**”. She initiated the session by talking about National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) which is designed to put **the teacher** at the center of the fundamental reforms in the education system in India. She further said that, it is a well-established fact that education is a lifelong process, and the teacher is the most important factor in each citizen's learning journey. She emphasized that all languages, even the so-called primitive ones, are capable of becoming media for school teaching; some perhaps merely as a bridge to a second language, while others may be used at all levels of education. Dr. Niraja Saraswat and Dr. Preeti Bhatt from MNIT, Jaipur, Dr. Shayamala, Mercy College and Ms. Sumayya Siddiqui from St. Xavier's College, Jaipur were the other resource persons in the FDP.
