
INSTITUTE


THE PRINCIPAL

International e-Conference on "Contemporary Issues and Challenges in Economy, Trade, Employment & Social Inclusion Post Covid-19:2.0"

February 25-26, 2022

The current corona virus pandemic is having a profound impact, not only on people's health, work and live. Among the most important challenges created by covid-19 is how to adapt a system of education built around physical schools. At its peak, more than 188 countries encompassing around 91% of enrolled learners worldwide closed their schools to try to contain the spread of the virus. Such thoughtful conditions gave us motivation to organize this conference. International e Conference on Contemporary issues and challenges in economy, trade, employment and social inclusion post covid-19:2.0 were organized by Department of Management Studies, SKIT, from 25th February 2022 to 26th February 2022. This Conference was conducted on Webex online platform. The program was inaugurated with Saraswati Vandana. Prof. Ona Ladiwal and Dr. Ravish Pandey were the Conveners of the conference. The event began with the welcome address by Prof. R. K Jain Sir Dean SKIT, who shared about the success story of SKIT to all the honoured guests and participants. 
